A mid-Victorian gold mounted oval shell cameo brooch, carved as a scene of St George and the Dragon with a maiden standing beside a tree, within a beaded and scrolling surround, unmarked, weight 20.4g, width 5.7cm, with a case.

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

740 - A couple of internal cracks running vertically on one side, to the side of the horse, can be seen under normal lighting. Crisp outline to the carving. A portion of the gold surmount is lacking, broken off in the past. The pin possibly a replacement, slightly discoloured. In good order. Safety chain pin is bent. General light surface wear/scratching to the mount. Overall in generally good condition for age. Case a little dirty and scuffed.

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
