Condition Report

415. Generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs. Rim and footrim with very minor misshaping, but hardly noticeable. Good clear hallmarks, but slightly rubbed. Handle in good order.

There is an applied oval cartouche to the front of the mug for the purpose of engraving a name, initials or inscription, but this is unengraved at present.
