Condition Report

466. The box is generally just a little on the tired side, so very much as it looks in the images on our website. There is a small dent to the cover just above the head of Peter the Great. Also a small dent to the left side of the hinge lid. Small dent to one corner and small dent to base. Also wear to niello work. Hinge is good, but the lid gapes slightly. Would certainly also benefit from a clean.
