An early 19th century gold and black enamel mourning ring, glazed with a woven hair locket compartment with floral decoration, detailed within the band 'Thomas Latham died 13 Augt 1818 aged 75', weight 8.4g, ring size approx N1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

571. The central glazed hair locket has some restoration to the black enamelled surround. The black enamel borders are otherwise in good condition. The inscription within the band is clear. Otherwise in generally good condition. The case is of the period of the ring but we cannot guarantee it is the original. The case would benefit from a wax polish. The lower half of the case hinge is a bit loose.

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
