An Austro-Hungarian silver gilt, pale turquoise and seed pearl parure, comprising a pendant necklace on a snap clasp, length 45cm, a bracelet on a snap clasp, length 19.5cm, a pair of pendant earrings with screw fittings, length 5.3cm, and a ring, ring size approx N, each in a scrolling foliate design, mounted with oval cabochon pale turquoises and turquoise beads within surrounds of seed pearls, total weight 59.6g.

Condition Report

730. Some variation of colour of the turquoise, possibly as a result of cleaning. The four large seed pearls to the necklace are imitation pearls. Generally the gilding is a little weak, again probably due to cleaning. There is almost no gilding to the ring. There are some green deposits around the outer edges of the seed pearls. Both the clasp tongue of the necklace and bracelet is marked. There is a mark to the ring shank 'KD' or 'KT'. Suggested age last quarter of the 19th century.

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
