A gold and lapis lazuli brooch in the classical taste, with bead and ropetwist wirework decoration, detailed '18K', weight 3.5g, width 3.2cm, and a Victorian gilt metal and varicoloured agate oval hinged bangle with applied bead and wirework decoration, inside width 5.5cm.

Condition Report

738. Lapis lazuli brooch – the hook is bent, marked 'TS'. The lapis cabochon is in good condition. The brooch is generally in good condition. Suggested age late Victorian.

Bangle – the front of the bangle is associated and has traces of where clasp fittings were to the two sides. It is likely that the surround to the agate is gold, the rest of the bangle being gold plated base metal. The agate has surface reaching inclusions to the green aspect of the stone. The agate looks to have been polished to disguise surface wear. Hinge in good condition. Clasp closes tightly.

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
