## LOT 742

An early 19th century gilt metal mounted varicoloured agate panel link bracelet, circa 1830, mounted with a row of eight oval cabochon varicoloured agates, on a snap clasp, length 18.5cm.

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## Condition Report

742. The cornelian link has restoration to the back nearest the clasp end, the cornelian is probably a replacement as it is flat cut to the centre rather than cabochon as the other agates are. Some of the base metal connecting links have been replaced. One panel set with the whitest agate is missing a bead, the clasp is also missing a bead. One bead on the cornelian link is bent. The cornelian link mount is much brighter than the other agates. The flower roundels either side of the agates (excluding the cornelian and the clasp) have been deliberately blackened.
