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An early 19th century gold, enamel, diamond and seed pearl pendant of elliptical form, mounted with a rose cut diamond set flower stem on a blue enamel ground within a white enamel border, with a rose cut diamond and seed pearl set tied ribbon surmount, weight 4.4g, length 3cm.

Condition Report

791. The blue enamel has a large chip and also numerous hair cracks. There is a chip to the white enamel below the pearl. The rose cut diamonds have a few internal inclusions. The top bow and flower are probably silver set. The flower motif is probably in association with the bow. The round suspension loop is probably also in association. Gold probably low grade.

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
