A single row necklace of graduated pearls, possibly natural saltwater, on a gold, opal and diamond cluster clasp, claw set with the principal circular opal within a surround of ten circular cushion shaped diamonds, total length 53.5cm, smallest pearl diameter 0.3cm, largest pearl diameter 0.6cm.

Condition Report

795. The opal has attractive play-of-colour. The surrounding diamonds slightly draw colour and some have one or two internal inclusions. The clasp is unmarked. Diameter of clasp 11mm. The chain connecting the pearls to the clasp is broken. There are added lengths of chain at either side of the clasp before the pearls start. There is variation of shape and lustre to the pearls.

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
