A 9ct gold circular pendant locket with floral engraved decoration to the front, weight including interior 8.3g, length 3.9cm, on a gold oval link neckchain, detailed '585', with a boltring clasp, weight 3.1g, length 49.5cm, and a silver gilt neckchain with an oval black enameled pendant locket, decorated with a floral spray, length 4cm.

Condition Report

798. Black enameled locket – suggested age circa 1880. There are a few minor surface nicks to the black enamel but in general it is in good condition. Hinge closes properly. Small dent to the top of the centre of the back. The locket is not hallmarked but is likely to be gold back and fronted and probably of Continental origin rather than English.

Circular pendant locket – maker 'C&F' to the suspension loop, Birmingham probably 1969. The hinge is in good condition. One small shallow dent to the back. Front in good condition. Both neckchains are in good condition.

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
