A late 18th century Maltese silver coffee pot, the urn shaped body with domed hinged cover and flower finial, flanked by a wooden scroll handle and scroll spout with bird head terminal, raised on three leaf shouldered scroll legs terminating in hoof feet, hallmarks to rim including indistinct maker's mark, possibly 'PL', weight 1062g, height 30cm.

Condition Report

391. The coffee pot is in generally good condition commensurate with age.

There is typical surface scratches and wear. Numerous small dents around the neck and some small dents to the body as well.

Hinge and hinge lid in good order and closes tightly.

All three legs appear to be in good condition with nice crisp detail to foliate shoulders.

Mark to neck is rubbed.

Handle is wobbly and loose and appear to have been damaged at some time and reduced slightly.
