An early 19th century Maltese silver ewer, maker's mark 'GD', of urn shaped form with faceted ovoid body, beaded rim and collar, flanked by a scroll handle, on a circular foot, hallmarks to foot including 'GD' maker's mark, weight 1023.5g, height 34.5cm.

Condition Report

392. The ewer is in generally good condition commensurate with age, with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear, with some minor nicks to body. Footrim is slightly misshapen and wobbles ever so slightly. Hinge has a bit of movement from side to side, but otherwise in good order. Hinge lid also in good order.

Hallmarks a little rubbed and indistinct.
