LOT 394

A late 18th century Maltese silver pedestal salver, maker's mark of Gio Carlo Cassar, the circular top with shaped and moulded piecrust rim, raised on a lobed and domed pedestal foot, hallmarks with maker's mark to rims, weight 882.2g, diameter 30.7cm, height 11.4cm. Note: Gio Carlo Cassar was granted his warrant in 1774 before he was appointed Consul for Silversmiths in 1806.

Estimate: £600 - £1,000

Condition Report

394. The salver top and foot are connected with a screw thread. The top salver section has a worn and dented central area which coincides with what appears to be a reinforced area to the underside around the central screw thread. Otherwise the salver section is in good condition with typical surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks along the rim.

The pedestal foot is in good order with small dent to upper rim, otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear. Matching marks to footrim.

Both sections screw together tightly.
