## LOT 305

A 19th century Dutch silver windmill wagner cup, the bell shaped bowl decorated in relief with fruit and leaves, the stem formed as six scrollwork brackets supporting the windmill with simulated plank decoration and a dial, above a miller ascending a ladder, marks worn, weight 197g, height 22.5cm (repaired).

## Condition Report

305. There are a number of lead repaired tears/splits to the rim, the longest of which is approx 3cm long and the shortest approx 0.5cm. Two of these have started to separate again. Otherwise the bell shaped body feels a little thin and tired, with few further minor lead repairs and very small visible holes to the upper section of the body.

The upper windmill section is in generally good order. There is some slight misshaping to the sails and the scroll supports have been pushed down and misshapen a little. The back wall of the windmill has a small split to the centre and there are some minor knocks and dents to other walls and roof.
