A pair of mid-18th century silver mounted cut glass oil and vinegar bottles, each facet cut body with a silver reeded spiral neck and tappit lid with shell thumbpiece, flanked by a foliate capped scroll handle, unmarked, height 20cm.

Condition Report

315. Generally good condition, one appears to have a small crack to inside of rim/neck but not obviously noticeable and hidden behind the silver mount, otherwise glass is good with only tiny nicks to edges of bases and facets. Typical surface scratches and wear. Silver in good order with good working hinges, only typical minor surface scratches and wear. No repairs. No hallmarks. Each hinge lid engraved with a crest.
