375. There is a lead repair all the way around the base. There are numerous small dents to the body as well as typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge lid is good and finial is in good order. Handle wobbles very slightly but is otherwise secure with small dent to one side and typical wear to high points. Good clear hallmarks.
