A George III silver inkstand of shaped rectangular form with gadrooned rim and two pen recesses, on scroll legs, the raised oval centre fitted with three cut glass inkwells and pounce pot, each with pierced silver cover, London 1804 by Robert Hennell I and Samuel Hennell, weight excluding glass bottles 539g, length 25.5cm.

Condition Report

445. Stand is in good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear but no significant damage or repairs. Cylindrical holders sit firmly in place with securing pins to underside. Good clear hallmarks to all pieces.

All 3 bottles and covers in generally good order with only tiny nicks to glass and typical wear. All covers fit tightly and are part hallmarked with all matching the stand.
