A Chinese turquoise enamelled and gilt moulded biscuit porcelain archaistic vase, mark of Qianlong but late Qing dynasty, the baluster body moulded in relief with gilt strapwork, all with keyfret detail, between lappet borders, flanked by a pair of mask and tongue handles, all reserved against a turquoise and lavender mottled ground, impressed and gilt seal mark to base, height 32cm.

## Condition Report

1050. Good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear but nothing significant. Some very minor crazing to glaze. There is a slight blemish to gilt decoration under the handle but this is in the manufacture so not subsequent damage, and again of no real significance.
