### Condition Report

1013. Teabowl - two tiny chips to rim and also some minor glaze fritting to rim. Otherwise good condition with no cracks. Some wear to gilt.

Saucer - generally good order as well but with a faint 1.3cm hairline to rim and a few minor chips to rim. Also typical light surface scratches and wear and wear to gilt.
