A pair of Chinese famille rose porcelain jars and covers, late Qing dynasty, each of barrel form with metal mounted finial and swing handles, painted with butterflies and flowers and birds flying above pink blossom on black waves, unmarked, height 17.5cm (minor faults).

## Condition Report

1155. Both with typical light surface scratches and wear.

Jar 1 - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. There is a very small chip to inner rim of jar and a small star crack to the body (approx 2.5cm long), this is only really noticeable from the interior as the black enamel covers it on the exterior. Cover in good order. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt on both pieces.

Jar 2 - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. No chips, cracks or repairs to either piece. Both with typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt with more pronounced wear to gilt borders on cover.
