### LOT 1161

A group of five Chinese famille export porcelain side plates, late Qianlong period, painted with cornucopia and flower spray within a pink festoon rim, diameter 16.2cm, together with small group of similar famille rose export porcelain teaware, two blue and white teabowls and an English porcelain teabowl, painted and gilt with pink flowers (some faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

1161. All pieces in the lot have typical surface scratches and wear commensurate with age.

Six saucers - all with typical surface scratches and wear. Five in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs, one with 2cm crack to rim.

Three matching teabowls - two in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs, the other with chip to rim. All with typical surface scratches and wear.

Famille rose bowl - 3cm hairline to rim, otherwise good condition, good vibrant colours.

Famille rose saucer - chip to rim and three 3cm hairlines to rim.

Five side plates - all generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs but all with minor rim chips and some minor paint loss.

Two blue and white teabowls - one with chip to rim and cracked, the other with hairline to rim and base of bowl.

European teabowl - generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs, typical wear and surface scratches to interior.
