A Chinese cloisonné bowl, early 20th century, of shallow circular form, decorated with dragons on a black ground to inside and out, diameter 17cm, together with a hardwood circular stand, the apron carved and pierced with ruyi heads and scrolling tendrils, diameter 15.5cm.

Condition Report

1099. In good condition overall with no restoration or significant damage. There is a minor spot of enamel loss to the outer edge of the turquoise base near the footrim, and a pinhead sized enamel nick to the green wave juxtaposed to this loss, on the other side of the footrim. The carved wooden base has a minor crack to the apron and two minuscule nicks to the upper rim edge.
