### LOT 1042

A collection of twenty-two Chinese hardwood stands, late Qing dynasty and later, including one of carved and pierced lotus form, diameter 10cm, a two-tier stand with pierced apron, length 26cm, and a carved and pierced cradle stand, decorated with peach branches, length 17.5cm, together with a Chinese hardwood domed cover, pierced with shou characters and scrolls, diameter 11.8cm (some with faults).

### Condition Report

1042. Two tier stand - generally good condition. Middle top section needs regluing as it has come unstuck.

Lotus stand - good condition.

Pierced dome cover - generally good condition, finial repaired.

Pierced tripod censer stand - good condition.

Cradle stand - good condition.

Circular stand with scroll leg and pierced apron - one foot broken and missing.

Small carved stand - one foot chipped.

Small circular stand - broken and missing section of apron.

All other stands in generally good condition with no apparent significant damage or repairs. Typical minor scuffs and scratches.
