An early 20th century Fabergé gold mounted nephrite jade paper knife, 56 zolotnik, with curved blade, the scroll handle with gold foliate edge and set with a pair of opposing cabochon moonstones, struck with Cyrillic maker's mark, 'H.W' workmaster's mark of Henrik Wigstrom and '56' standard mark, length 12cm, within original holly wood box, total length 14cm.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

2458 - The general condition overall is good. There is some glue residue visible through a lens around one of the moonstones where it has been re-attached. The inside of the case is slightly worn with the hinge area of the silk being shot. Some minor wear to exterior of case.
