## LOT 1275

A Chinese blue silk embroidered dragon robe, late Qing dynasty, worked in gilt thread with nine dragons within a surround of vapours and Buddhistic emblems above rocks, waves and diagonal stripes, the black collar similarly decorated, fitted with gilt metal fastenings, length 131cm (some faults).

Estimate: £400 - £600

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## Condition Report

1275. The robe is worn with some fairly significant unstitching to gilt thread all over the robe. Colours are still quite good. Wear and fraying to edges. No lining and missing cuffs. One gilt metal fastener missing and one replaced.

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
