A collection of Chinese silk embroidered textiles, late Qing dynasty and later, including a patterned blue padded robe, length 131cm, and a black silk shawl, worked in coloured threads with birds and flowers, 112cm x 112cm, with tasselled fringe border.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1339 - Padded blue robe - overall wear and some losses to edges. Some staining and more significant staining and holes to back.

Black table cover/shawl - good vibrant colours and generally good clean condition.

Cream table cover/shawl - generally good condition, creased and some light staining and minor un-threading.

Pale pink coat - badly worn with some staining and missing collar.

Blue ground square pillow case - badly worn and some staining.

Gilt thread Buddhist lion panel - badly worn background and threads becoming unstitched in most areas.

Blue and gilt dragon robe - some wear and unstitching, no lining or borders/collar.

Yellow ground dragon panel - yellow ground badly worn/fraying and split and tears across middle. Needlework itself is pretty good.

Hat - worn and stained with some holes.

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
