A Chinese famille rose Mandarin palette export porcelain saucer, Qianlong period, painted with a figural scene, diameter 12.1cm, together with a group of other Chinese porcelain, including a Canton famille rose ovoid jar, height 13cm, two cylindrical brushpots, heights 14.5cm and 10cm, and four famille rose bowls (minor faults).

Condition Report

1323. Large iron red decorated brush pot - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor wear to glaze and enamels.

Small brush pot - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Small jar and cover - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Famille rose ginger jar - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical wear to enamels and some minor enamel loss.

Saucer - good condition, no significant damage. Minor chip/glaze flake to rim and typical light surface wear and scratches.

Millefleur bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Two Canton famille rose bowls - one with tiny chip to rim and typical light surface scratches and wear, otherwise good condition.

Dragon bowl - 5cm hairline to rim, otherwise ok.
