A Regency mahogany window seat, in the manner of Charles Heathcote Tatham, the rectangular seat flanked by cylindrical ends, raised on reeded tapering legs, height 48cm, width 117cm, depth 35.5cm (some faults).

Condition Report

2120. The seat appears to have been made in the early/mid-19th century. It has overall typical minor surface marks, scratches and knocks. Both of the ends have cracks running along the top surface where it meets the seat, front to back, with some slight surface loss to these areas. Overall knocks to the corners and edges of the legs. The underside shows some fairly minor woodworm to rails and the lack of some of the corner blocks of wood. The central support rail is also lacking a screw.
