A near pair of Chinese blue and white porcelain vases, Kangxi period, each baluster body painted with four vertical arched panels, filled with flowers, heights 15.9cm and 16.1cm (one with chip and neck repair, both with typical rim and footrim chips).

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

1004. Vase 1 - two small chips to rim and five small chips to footrim, otherwise body is in good condition with good vibrant decoration. Typical light surface scratches.

Vase 2 - chipped section of rim (1cm x 2cm) and small section of rim broken out and re-glued (approx 2cm x 3.5cm). Seven small chips to footrim. Diagonal crack to body (approx 7.5cm long). Typical light surface scratches.
