## LOT 1027

A Chinese blue and white porcelain snuff bottle, late 19th century, the cylindrical body painted with precious vessels within stiff leaf borders, height 10cm (hairline crack and reduced rim), together with an iron red decorated porcelain snuff bottle, late Qing dynasty, painted with a dragon, vapours and flaming pearl, height 7.6cm (chip to rim and footrim and hairline crack to body).

Estimate: £80 - £120

## Condition Report

1027. Blue and white bottle - chipped and ground down rim with a couple of small hairlines around the same area. Also a hairline crack running vertically up the side of the body (approx 6cm in length).

Red decorated bottle - chip and small hairline to rim and a 4cm vertical crack to body. Numerous small chips to footrim.
