### LOT 1255

A Chinese pale celadon jade plaque, probably late Qing dynasty, of square form, carved and pierced with lotus and leaves, width 8.4cm, together with a group of seven hardstone and glass snuff bottles, heights ranging from 5.4cm to 7cm.

Estimate: £200 - £400

### Condition Report

1255. Plaque - good condition, few very minor nicks/chips but no significant damage or repairs.

Pale celadon flattened ovoid bottle - good condition, couple of tiny nicks to rim.

Darker celadon flattened ovoid bottle - good condition.

Green speckled bottle - good condition, few tiny nicks to rim.

Rounded tapered bottle - good condition, small internal hairlines.

Carved mask handle bottle - good condition.

Agate oval bottle - generally good, tiny nicks and wear.

Small bottle incised with butterflies - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
