A collection of twenty-nine Japanese Satsuma earthenware circular buttons, early 20th century, including a set of seven painted with Noh masks on a black and gilt ground, diameter 2.7cm (one damaged), a set of four painted and gilt with landscapes, diameter 2.7cm, a set of seven painted with the Gods of Good Fortune, diameter 2.5cm, and a set of six painted and gilt with sailing boats and pine tree, diameter 2.4cm.

Condition Report

1007. Seven non mask buttons - one with missing broken section, otherwise all six others in good condition with typical light crazing and only minor wear to gilt and decoration.

All of the other buttons are in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing with only minor wear to gilt and enamels.
