Two Continental porcelain Chelsea style miniature scent bottles, 19th century, probably Samson, one modelled as a putto seated on a dolphin, height 7.3cm, the other as a seated cupid, height 7cm, each with gilt anchor mark to base, together with other pieces of miniature porcelain, including a vase and cover with pink and gilt decoration and a Derby scent bottle, early 19th century, with foliate gilt decoration (lacking stopper).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1365. Dolphin scent bottle - repaired and chipped tail, chips to base, small unglazed section to neck.

Seated Cupid - very small losses to flowers/foilage.

Pair of Dresden style ladies - both have restored necks, the stopper to one is stuck inside, the head itself is loose.

Pink vase - chip to lid finial, some minor losses to gilt rim.

Barrel with putto scent bottle - lacking finial to stopper, chipped hand.

Three classical ladies scent bottle - chips to stopper.

Derby vase - faint small hairline to rim, some losses to gilt decoration, particularly on neck.

Derby character jug - small chip to rim of hat.

Seated figure scent bottle - crown a little loose on stopper, build up of dirt/white residue in creases.

Cylindrical bottle - in good condition.

Lady holding tray - re-glued hands and tray.

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
