### LOT 1245

A Barr Worcester porcelain Two Quail pattern part service, 1792-1804, decorated in the Kakiemon palette, comprising teapot, cover and stand, seven breakfast cups and saucers, eight further cups of various sizes and six saucers, slop bowl, sucrier and cover, muffin dish and cover, five egg cups, four side plates, two saucer dishes and two dinner plates, incised 'B' mark to bases (faults).

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

### Condition Report

1245 - Teapot - the finial has been re-glued, long hairline running around the teapot. Small chip and some minor restoration to the rim of the lid.

Muffin dish and cover - the finial has been re-glued and restored.

Sucrier - the finial is restored and has become detached. Repaired chip to the underside of the lid with over-gilding. Hairline crack to the body of the sucrier.

Slop bowl - badly cracked, with two areas of obvious rim restoration

Four egg cups damaged, cracked or restored

Two breakfast bowls cracked, one with tiny hairline to handle

Two breakfast bowl saucers cracked

Three other cups cracked or repaired

Six saucers cracked or repaired

One saucer dish cracked

All other pieces are in good condition, with only minor surface wear and some wear to the gilt rims.
