A Royal Worcester George V coronation vase, liner and cover, circa 1911, the bulbous body painted by Rushton, signed, with a view of Windsor Castle within a gilt foliate cartouche opposing a crown, the royal cypher of George V and 'June 22 1911', against a cobalt blue ground, the cover in the form of the coronation crown, green printed marks and shape No. 2516 to base, height 16.5cm (hairline crack to base, finial repaired).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1352 - In generally good condition. The finial of the crown has been re-glued with some over-gilding. The main body has a hairline to the base. A small separate hairline by the foot, approx. 1cm in length. Some minor rubbing to the gilt where the lid meets the body.
