A Meissen figure emblematic of the sense Hearing, 19th century, modelled after Schönheit as a lady seated at a piano, the shaped base with egg and dart type moulding picked out in gilt, crossed swords in underglaze blue and impressed No. 36 to base, height 12.3cm.

Condition Report

1357 - Minor losses to the lattice work on the head. A small section of the left sleeve is lacking, with the tiniest of nicks to the corner of the piano on this side also. A few nicks and small chips to the rim of the base, many of which have been touched up with re-gilding.
