A Poole pottery vase, circa 1922-37, designed by Truda Carter, painted by Ruth Pavely, the tapering cylindrical body decorated with 'YE' pattern, impressed marks and painted artist's monogram to base, height 18.5cm, together with another Poole pottery vase, 1930s, decorated with 'JV' pattern, height 14.5cm.

### Condition Report

1247. YE pattern vase - in generally good condition, overall crazing some of which on the rim is ever so slightly stained. Small chip/manufacturing fault to the glaze on the rim where you can see the red pottery body beneath.

JV pattern vase - in generally good condition, overall crazing. Slight manufacturing fault where the glaze hasn't fully covered the pottery body where the footrim meets the body.
