A pair of Derby porcelain figures of a sailor and his lass, circa 1760, the sailor modelled holding a stick and gold coins in his outstretched hand, the lass beckoning him with her arm, each against a bocage, raised on a scroll base, patch marks to bases, height of tallest 26.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

### Condition Report

1359 - Male: small chip to one finger on the outstretched hand. Some general losses to the foliage on the bocage, with a larger portion lacking on the left side as viewed from the front. Small chip to the underside of the base. Otherwise ok.

Female: A few chips to the rim of the hat. Missing one finger and a small chip to the baggy sleeve on the opposite arm. General losses to the foliage of the bocage and base. Otherwise ok.
