A Derby porcelain figure group of a dancing couple, circa 1835, modelled in 18th century dress, raised on a flower encrusted gilt scroll base, crossed swords in underglaze blue and incised number '16' to base, height 16.5cm. Note: a similar figure group is illustrated in 'Derby Porcelain 1748-1848 An Illustrated Guide' by John Twitchett, page 142.

Condition Report

1360 - In fairly good condition. A few minor losses to the lattice work on the lady's corset and dress. Minor losses to the flowers in the hair and on the base. Small chip to interior rim of the hat. Missing portions of the sword at both ends. Small chunk on the scroll decorated base has been chipped away, left of the lady. Faint firing crack to the base.
