A Mintons porcelain ice pail, late 19th century, the U-shaped body painted with a continuous Venetian waterside scene, flanked by a pair of scroll handles, on a circular foot, printed mark to base, height 17cm (hairline cracked).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1370 - There are a couple of faint hairline cracks to the rim, one runs under one handle and shows through on the interior of the jardiniere. There is another faint hairline to the other handle. There is a star crack to the base. Some losses to the gilding, largely on the foot rim. Some typical surface wear to the interior. Some scratching and minor losses of paint to the decorated exterior, near the bottom of the design.
