A large Continental porcelain figure group The Triumph of Bacchus, modelled after Joseph Le Riche for Sèvres, late 19th/early 20th century, depicting a seated Bacchus surrounded by attendants, raised on a naturalistic oval base, indistinct mark to base, height 37.5cm (crack to base).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1326. Length 34cm, width 24cm.

The crack runs almost the full length of the base and runs up the figure group on one side beside the girl holding the wreath crown, stopping just behind her feet. In the past, restoration has been attempted but this has largely flaked off.

Thumb missing from one hand of the lady holding the jug. A chipped remnant of decoration to the front where a bowl would have been.

Small repair to the collar of the leopard. Bacchus was probably once holding something in his left hand which is now lacking.
