A rare Royal Doulton figure of The Young Widow, HN1399, designed by L. Harradine, height 21cm (crack to base and body).

Estimate: £500 - £700

Condition Report

1632 - There is some cracking which begins at the base and forks in two directions along the base and up the body of the figure group. One part travels up the back of the figure and across the back of the lady's shawl, forking again, one crack stops at her left shoulder, the other travels across the back of the boy. The other part travels up the side of the base from the opposite end. There is a third crack which starts on the base under the basket and runs up the legs of the boy, across his waist and stops in between the two figures. There are a few nibbles to the flower petals and a small portion of the green foliage of the hand bouquet is lacking.
