A Wedgwood Flying Hummingbirds lustre bowl, 1920s, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, the interior gilt with a hummingbird within a Flying Geese decorated rim, against an orange lustre ground, the exterior similarly decorated with various hummingbirds against a blue lustre ground, gilt printed Portland vase mark and pattern No. Z5294 to base, diameter 16.6cm.

Condition Report

1670. In generally good condition. Light scratching to the interior of the bowl. Some small and very minor scratching to the exterior of the bowl. There is a manufacturing fault within the interior where areas of orange glaze are lacking. Some minor wear to the gilding, mainly on the footrim.
