A set of eight hard paste porcelain plates, 19th century, painted in French style with scattered flowers within a rim of cornflowers with gilt foliage, underglaze blue Nyon fish mark to bases, diameter 18.7cm, together with a Vienna teapot and cover, late 18th/early 19th century, height 12.5cm (restored), and a teacup with landscape view and foliate monogram, red painted anchor mark to base (lacking handle).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

8 plates - 3 with small professionally executed area of restoration to rim, 3 with small chips to the footrim, one with small decorated over manufacturer's chip to upper rim edge, one with some minor wear to the gilding.

Otherwise the enamelling and gilding on the plates is all in good order with very little wear.

Teapot - restoration and re-gilding to tip of spout, otherwise in good condition.

Cup - completely lacking handle, tiny chip to inner rim edge above where handle would have been, even smaller chip to outside edge of footrim.
