### LOT 1606

A Royal Doulton flambé vase, early 20th century, of bulbous form, printed mark to base, height 21cm, a Royal Doulton flambé shaped circular bowl, designed by C.J. Noke, decorated with a cottage within a landscape, printed mark and painted signature to base, diameter 30cm, and a Royal Lancastrian vase, covered in a matt green glaze, impressed marks to base, height 14cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

### Condition Report

Doulton vase - In good condition overall with no chips or restoration. There are some long craze lines visible to the glaze, particularly to the underside of the foot where one of these lines runs across the diameter of the base and is able to be felt with your fingernail.

Bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are some light surface scratches visible particularly to the bowl interior.

Lancastrian vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Some very minor crazing to the glaze.
