A pair of pearlware leaf shaped pickle dishes, late 18th/early 19th century, length 13.4cm, another pearlware pickle dish, printed with a version of the Willow pattern, and a Chinese Canton leaf dish, mid-19th century, painted with a chinoiserie landscape (minor faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1495. Pearlware leaf dishes - 1) couple of chips to the rim, small firing crack to the underside, small manufacturing blemish to one side. 2) chip to point of leaf, small firing crack near stem and an area of staining in same location.

Willow pattern - four of the pointed edges of the leaf are badly chipped, a few nibbles generally to rim also.

Chinese leaf - minor glaze chipping to rim, otherwise ok.
