A mixed group of Worcester porcelain, second half 18th century, including a blue bordered fluted French shape circular dish, painted to the centre with an exotic bird within gilt floral garlands, diameter 20cm, a small plate, painted in the style of James Giles with an exotic bird, diameter 15.8cm, and a blue scale ground hexagonal teapot stand with panels of birds and butterflies, diameter 14cm, various painted marks (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1263. Exotic bird blue fluted plate - some scratches and small losses to the bird motifs, otherwise in generally good condition.

Other exotic bird plate - some minor wear in places to the gilt rim. Couple of manufacturing blemishes on rim. Otherwise in generally good condition.

Chinese motifs cup and saucer - cup is lacking handle, firing crack to base.

Pink rimmed bowl - minor wear to decoration, otherwise ok.

Hexagonal blue ground dish - light surface wear, otherwise ok.

Cylindrical mug - small crack to rim, with staining, general wear and pitting to rim, otherwise ok.

Other three pieces badly broken.
