Two Royal Worcester cream jugs of coopered tapering form, each with a naturalistic handle, one painted with a 'Bullfinch', by William Powell, signed, circa 1929, printed factory marks and painted title to base, height 7cm (restoration), the other painted with a 'Chaffinch', by Allan Norwood, signed, circa 1956, printed factory mark and painted title to base, height 8cm, together with three other cream jugs.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1562. Blue banded jug - cracks to rim, fine crazing.

Bullfinch jug - restored, extensive crack running through vase which has been overpainted but is still visible.

Plain jug - very minor wear to gilt.

Chaffinch jug - in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Pink/yellow jug - some restoration to spout on one side.
