A Copeland Parian ewer, second half 19th century, painted with a border of trumpet flowers and foliage, impressed mark and painted No. '9441' to base, height 22cm, together with a Minton Parian ewer, painted with a portrait of a classical lady and gilt floral garlands, height 21cm, and four similar ewers and jugs.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1270. Copeland ewer - good condition, bit dirty and dusty, and minor wear to gilt.

3 other Parian jugs/ewers - generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface scratches and wear to gilt.

Blue jug - small chip to base, otherwise ok.

Pewter lidded jug - ok, but some staining and crazing to glaze on body and handle. Typical surface scratches and wear.
