A mixed group of Continental porcelain floral painted tablewares, late 19th and 20th century, including a French circular tureen and cover with lemon knob, a Thuringian leaf shaped dish and a coffee pot and cover, height 27.5cm, together with a black ground Helena Wolfsohn type équille, cover and stand, length of stand 24.5cm, and a Ginori dish (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1572. French lemon tureen - cover is restored to the interior and to the rim, base with some heavy wear to the gilt rim.

Wolfsohn equelle, cover and stand - base has been restored in four places on the interior of the rim, overgilding/painting to exterior. The stand has been restored to one side and to footrim.

Fluted cup - restored extensively. Similar saucer - cracked and chipped.

Jug and cover - a few losses to finial.

Coffee pot - restored spout, re-glued finial, old staple repair to handle.

Most restoration has discoloured and is noticeable. Overall some wear to the decoration and gilding in all pieces. Pieces not specifically mentioned are in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
